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INTRODUCTION

Premier Mobile Health Services was founded in 2018 by Nadine “Deanie” Singh, a Registered, Board-certified Nurse Practitioner and the Executive Director. Premier currently consists of 2 mobile medical clinics and a walk-in medical clinic. They provide care to the medically vulnerable and uninsured children and families in Fort Myers, FL and neighboring communities.

Several years ago, while pursuing her master’s degree in nursing, Deanie’s capstone was about owning a **mobile medical** clinic after retiring from her full-time job. However, three and a half years later, while working at the local hospital, Deanie discovered that so many young African American males were on dialysis. To add to that, they were being diagnosed with chronic, yet preventable diseases such as hypertension, diabetes, obesity, and other life-threatening illnesses. Those outcomes could have been different if they had sought medical care earlier in their lives.

That is when Deanie decided to buy her first medical unit and **make a difference** in the community and soon in greater America.

Premier Mobile Health Services is celebrated as a teaching facility and quality health care provider in Lee County and is partnered with notable institutions such as the University of Miami and Vanderbilt University.

Our philosophy of **partnership and collaboration** is the key to our success and growth. Through these partnerships we serve as a vehicle for delivering practical solutions to health care disparities in our community.

When **Hurricane Ian** hit Southwest Florida, Premier Mobile Health was one of the first organizations to be on the ground helping. We deployed our mobile units to the hardest hit areas to take care of the sick and wounded by providing **free** healthcare to them.

We **partnered** with different organizations like Project Hope, Lee Health, AmeriCares, and Direct Relief to bring medical help and everyday supplies to people that had lost it all.

We are currently still working on providing **free healthcare** resources to the community and we will continue working to **rebuild** our beloved Southwest Florida.

Reach the most impacted and vulnerable communities

In addition to placing one of our mobile clinics in the most affected areas, we also had our other mobile unit going to other areas in Southwest Florida, and our walk-in clinic in Fort Myers open offering free healthcare services for everyone that needed medical attention. Our mobile clinic also became a point of distribution of basic necessities to the community. We supplied cleaning supplies, hygiene products, clothes, toys, blankets, mattresses, water, and food to the people that lost everything because of the storm. We brought warm food for those that were not able to get food or cook their food because of the devastation.

Partner with other organizations

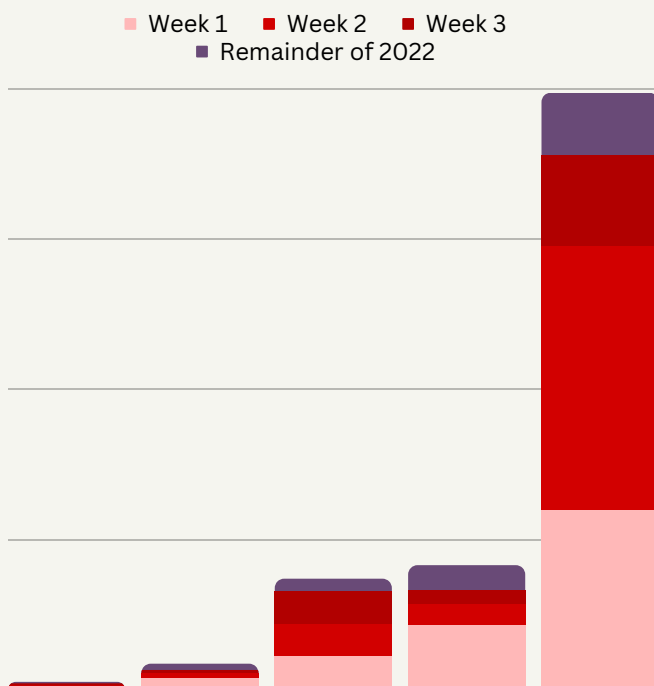
