Our mobile clinic is more than a service; it is a lifeline for those who need us most. We have witnessed the resilience of young mothers, individuals experiencing homelessness, and elderly community members navigating complex challenges. In addition, we have responded to the COVID-19 pandemic and aided with hurricane recovery for the last several years.

Each story is a testament to the strength and vulnerability of the human spirit. Through these experiences, we have gained invaluable insights into the unique barriers our community faces, allowing us to provide tailored support and guidance that can lead to better health outcomes.

Together, we can create a healthier environment where everyone has access to the care they deserve. Through collaboration with partners and donors, we are able to provide lifesaving medical care for free or at deeply reduced rates.

Looking ahead to 2026 and beyond, we are excited for our growth, from strengthening community partnerships to our role as a teaching facility for medical students. Impact of Your Support

For many in our community, we are the only place to turn.

A mother putting off care because she can't afford it.

A senior choosing between medication and groceries.

A neighbor who would otherwise go without.

Every day, we meet them where they are — delivering vital care through our mobile clinics and walk-in services. This care keeps people out of the hospital, reduces strain on the healthcare system and provides access for those who have been left behind.

But care like this doesn't happen without significant resources.

A single mobile clinic costs over **\$500,000**. Keeping it on the road — fuel, maintenance, insurance and staffing — requires thousands each month. Even the most basic elements of care quickly add up: **\$250 for lab work, \$50 for medical supplies.**

Grants help, but they don't sustain this work. Without additional support, access to this care is at risk.
